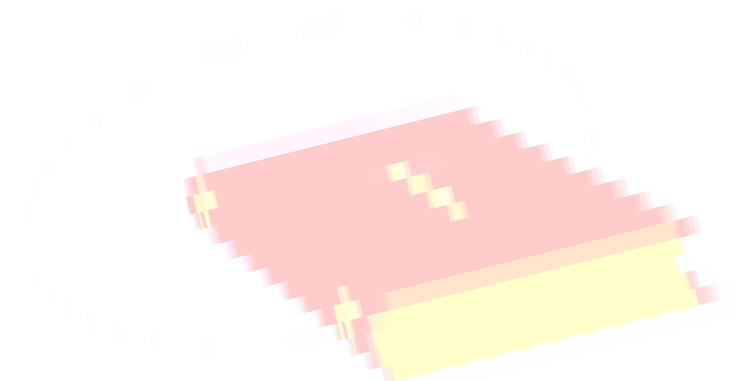

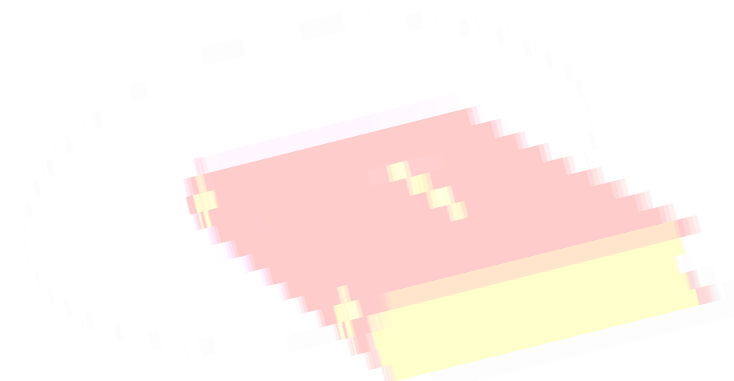

We will have shorter portions of the same passage in age appropriate lengths. The youngest children (3-4 year olds) will memorize one verse a month which will be the **bold section**, young children (5 yrs.-3rd grade) will memorize the underlined the part of the verse. And the older children will memorize the entire passage. But we would encourage you to challenge your child to learn as much of the verse as possible regardless of age based on their individual ability.

May God use these verses that our children are learning, not only to save them, but to equip them so that they will be a pillar and support of the truth in the coming generation.
